Currently on show at the Cisternerne in Frederiksberg, **Seven Deaths** is a world-renowned piece created by cult performance artist Marina Abramović (until November 30; Søndermarken opposite Zoo; frederiksborgmuseerne.dk). This cinematic installation presents seven iconic female roles from opera history and the deaths of these famous heroines: Violetta, Tosca, Carmen, Desdemona, Cio-Cio-San, Lucia di Lammermoor, and Norma. The seven films run as a continuous sequence with a total running time of approximately one hour. The voice of the legendary Maria Callas accompanies a visually rich staged universe created by Abramović and her on-screen partner Willem Dafoe that reflects deeply on longing, love, loss, life, and death. The setting adds an extra dimension – Cisternerne is an underground contemporary art space set in the dimly lit subterranean chambers of a former water reservoir.

April dresses Copenhagen in every shade of pink – come enjoy the cherry blossoms in full bloom! The **Sakura Festival** set in photogenic Langelinie Park, where nearly 200 blooming trees steal the show, offers visitors a glimpse of traditional Japanese culture (April 18–19; sakurafestival.dk). The programme of festivities includes tea ceremonies, live music, traditional martial arts and drum shows, kimono displays, and cosplay contests. On Saturday evening, Copenhagen Strings performs music from the beloved *Studio Ghibli* anime films. Meanwhile, Tivoli Gardens, that iconic landmark of the Danish capital, is also celebrating its awakening from the winter sleep with floral displays, evening concerts, ballet performances at the Pantomime Theatre, and a rich programme of family-friendly open-air events (tivoli.dk).

# COPENHAGEN



Hotel Bella Grande

The **Bella Grande** is a new boutique hotel in the heart of Copenhagen just a short walk from City Hall and other central attractions (Vester Voldgade 25; hotelbellagrande.com; from DKK 1088). The building itself dates to 1899 and has a romantic Italian-style indoor courtyard. The design team from the *Tonen* agency was likewise inspired by the structured beauty of Italian palazzos. Accordingly, the bright, lively atrium as well as the *Donna* restaurant have tender pink and rich red accents. Nostalgic charm meets modern sophistication in the hotel's 109 rooms, which feature dressing tables, mirrors, silk lampshades, and a muted colour palette.
