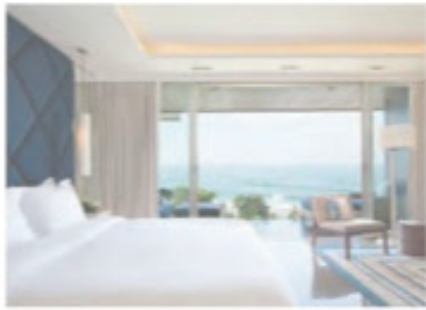

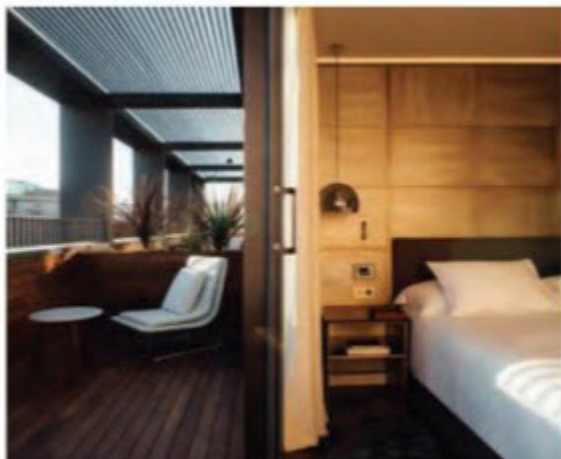


Long haul Private Island Paradise
